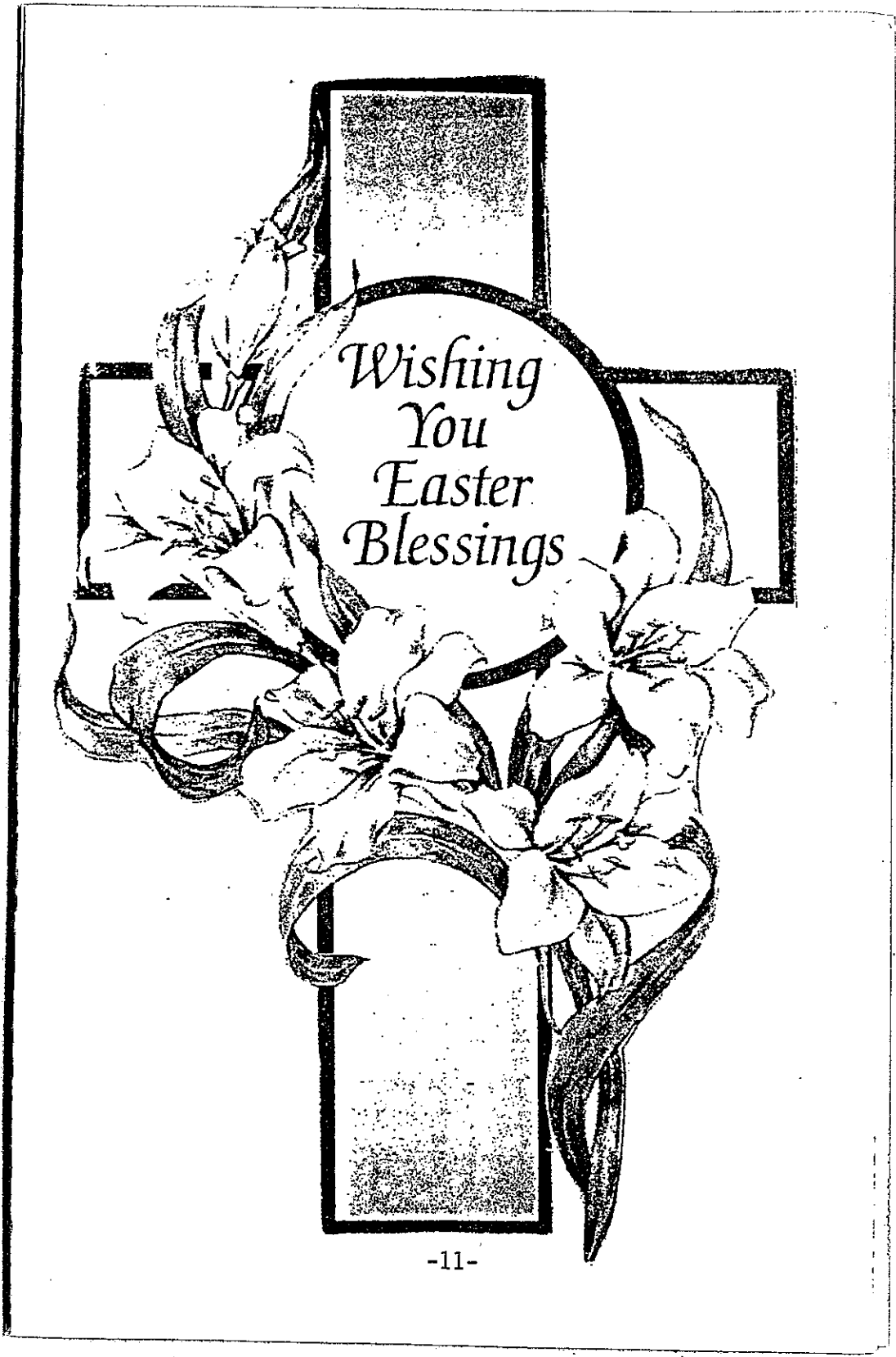

WE REAP WHAT WE PLANT!

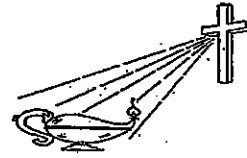
*If you plant honesty, You will reap trust.

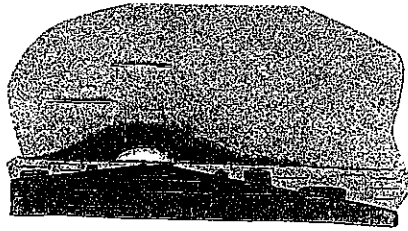

Make your reservations now to attend the 23rd annual retreat. This year, the **Bible Study** will be presented in **The Ritter Room** on the 2nd level with a glass wall facing toward the river and a patio outside the glass doors. A smaller breakout room next door to the Ritter Room is also available for some of the Small Group meetings. (**We will not use the Chapel.**) Registration is \$25.00 per person and is non refundable. The cost of meals and room added to the registration make the **total fee** as follows:

Single Room \$ 392 per person

Double Room \$ 275 per person

Triple Room \$ 215 per person

Quad Room \$ 195 per person

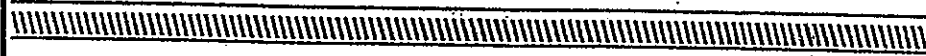

BALTIMORE EAST CLUSTER SHARES

In early September, 2010, Prince of Peace held the East
Baltimore Cluster Meeting -- having two different
speakers that were very informative -- one from the
Seafarers and the other from Lutheran Mission Society.
The meeting was very well attended.
